

3. **Income criteria.** The Act requires scholarship organizations to make awards only to those who qualify on income criteria established under the Act. Household income does not include: disability payments; worker's compensation; retirement pensions; public assistance or unemployment compensation; reimbursement for work-related expenses; employer or union payments for hospitalization, death benefits, supplemental unemployment; strike benefits; social security and retirement; and combat pay for military personnel.
