2016-2017 SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS BY GRADE

Below is the list of items that you will need to supply for your child.

Please mark your child's name on personal items, including clothing, for easy identification.

Each Family: One sample size Hand Sanitizer for Trash-A-Thon

Pre-Kindergarten:

1. Backpack that is large enough to fit a regular sized school folder
2. Large box of facial tissues to give to teacher to be used throughout the year
3. A reusable water bottle

Kindergarten:

1. **LARGE** book bag and lunch box
2. Large box of facial tissues to give to teacher to be used throughout the year
3. 1 pack of stickers

Grade 1:

1. Pencil box (size 5"x 8"- no zippers please) with pencils and one eraser. Please put name on
2. Large box of facial tissues to give to teacher to be used throughout the year
3. Paint shirt with name on it (not plastic or flannel, short sleeves – if father's shirt)
4. A pair of old socks to be used as Whiteboard erasers

Grade 2:

1. Pencil box (approx. size 5"x8") with (2) pencils and one eraser
2. Large box of facial tissues to give to teacher to be used throughout the year
3. Paint shirt with name on it (not plastic or flannel)
4. A pair of old socks to be used as Whiteboard erasers
5. Personal copy of the New International version of the Bible (ex. New Adventure Bible) for use in the classroom. Copies should have **TYPE LARGE ENOUGH TO READ EASILY** and include helps, such as concordance, maps, or Bible dictionary. (Print date 1984)

Grade 3:

1. Pencil box (5"x8") and a back pack without wheels preferred due to the steps to the lower level grade 3 classrooms
2. Large box of facial tissues to give to teacher to be used throughout the year
3. Paint shirt with name on it (not plastic or flannel)
4. A pair of old socks to be used as Whiteboard erasers
5. Personal copy of the New International version (ex. New Adventure Bible) of the Bible for use in the classroom when needed. Copies should have **TYPE LARGE ENOUGH TO READ EASILY** and include helps, such as a concordance, maps, or Bible dictionary. (Print date 1984)
6. Pre-laundered plain white T-shirt with name on tag; (will wear at end of school yr. get a size larger)
7. 1 pack multiplication flash cards clearly labeled with name

Grade 4:

1. Pencil pouch
2. Large box of facial tissues to give to teacher to be used throughout the year
3. Paint shirt with name on it (not plastic or flannel)
4. 3-ring 1 ½ " binder with 2 pockets (no oversized binders. They don't fit in desks. Subject dividers will be provided.
5. Personal copy of the New International version (ex. New Adventure Bible) of the Bible for use in the classroom when needed. Copies should have **TYPE LARGE ENOUGH TO READ EASILY** and include helps, such as a concordance, maps, or Bible dictionary. (Print date 1984)

Grade 5:

1. Pencil pouch to fit in notebook
2. Large box of facial tissues to give to teacher to be used throughout the year
3. Paint shirt with name on it (not plastic or flannel)
4. 3-ring binder (Subject dividers will be provided.)
5. (5) One-Subject Wide-Ruled Notebooks
5. Personal copy of the New International version (ex. New Adventure Bible) of the Bible for use in the classroom when needed. Copies should have **TYPE LARGE ENOUGH TO READ EASILY** and include helps, such as a concordance, maps, or Bible dictionary. (Print date 1984)

Grades 6, 7, 8:

Each Grade 6-8 student will be issued an assignment book. Middle school students will receive study skills instruction. Therefore, they must have the following:

1. Three ring loose-leaf notebook with subject dividers *...or...* folder for each subject in as many different colors as possible and a large supply of notebook paper (not college-ruled)
2. Red pen, blue pen, & highlighter
3. Good erasers and several pencils
4. Pencil pouch to fit in notebook
5. Scientific Calculator
6. "Active" Public Library card – please renew library card if it is more than 3 years old
7. Two large boxes of facial tissues to give to homeroom teacher to be used throughout the year
8. Bible (NIV print date 1984) for use in the classroom when needed. Copies should have type large enough to read easily and include helps, such as concordance, maps, or Bible dictionary
9. Protractor – clear, see through, translucent
10. Two Pocket folder (1)
11. Each 6th grade student will need (1) flash drive (7th & 8th grade students also need a flash drive, but can reuse their flash drive from last year)
