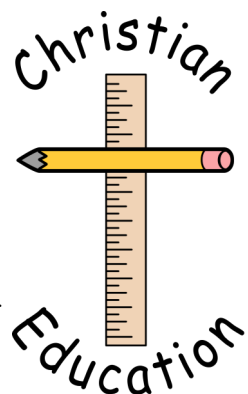
Your Commitment
